

A Beginner's Guide to Using Interactive Whiteboards across the Curriculum



Delegates will learn some Whiteboard tricks of the trade to keep students engaged, enthusiastic, and learning fast. This is a "Hands-On" course, during which colleagues will practise adding sound, video and external links to IWB presentations, as well as creating activities such as "the box of truth" and "scratchcards", which will have students desperate to come to the board.

A wide variety of exciting intermediate functions common to all whiteboards will be demonstrated, as well as a range of shortcuts and ways of exploiting existing materials interactively.

The aims of this course are to:

- Learn how to make more professional, varied and effective flipcharts quickly
- Gain inspiration for using the IWB appropriately in your subject
- Understand how to use shortcuts to save yourself time and share and adapt flipcharts between colleagues
- Increase the "wow factor" of IWB-based lessons
